Government task force led by B. Baasandorj, Head of Authority of Government Supervisory composed of the State Secretaries of all 16 Ministries and Cabinet Secretariat to redevelop Resolution N.206 on "Monitoring & Evaluation of Policy Documents' Implementation and Administrative Organizations' Operation" had been kicked-off on June 29, 2023.

Mongolian Evaluation Association (MEA) is honored to be a part of the task force to contribute with technical expertise and be the bridge of international expertise. This privileged task is in line with Mongolian Evaluation Association's Vision 'To promote professionalization and institutionalization of evaluation at the national level in Mongolia. The redeveloped draft will be submitted to Government discussion in August, 2023.

Module 4: Evaluation Planning and Management


